## **New National Guidelines, Information, and Policies Updates:**

- The National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute (NHLB) has some new research out on understanding the long term effects of COVID-19. [The report can be found here.](#)
- In a study comparing the genes of thousands of coronavirus patients in Europe, researchers found that those with Type A blood were more likely to have a severe case of the disease, while the severity was much less for those with Type O blood. [Read a report on the study.](#)
- Dexamethasone, a low-cost, widely available steroid drug used to treat rheumatoid arthritis, asthma and some cancers, reduced deaths by 35 percent in COVID-19 patients who needed to be on a ventilator and 20 percent in those who required oxygen but were not ventilated, according to British clinical trials announced Tuesday.
